Dear Parents & Guardians,

Dress Rehearsal:

Important note:

Please note that Nursery children are not participating in the dress-rehearsal.

Parents are requested to drop their children at school as usual.

Christmas Show on Saturday 5th December:

Our Christmas Show will be held at ICCS Auditorium. Parents are requested to bring their children straight to the venue by 8-8.30 a.m. The children must arrive ready in their costumes. The respective class teachers will be there to receive the children. The program will start at 9 a.m. sharp so parents are requested to be seated in the hall by 8.30 a.m.

This year it will be different because of the Covid-19 and we must follow the guidelines of MOH of social distancing and other relevant precautions.

In regards with the health guidelines we are allowed one parent from each family as the hall capacity is 500 seats only, we can occupy 250 seats and it means that we must sit on alternative chairs.

Parents are requested to wear mask when entering the hall.

Our play is called 'Rapunzel'

The traditional story of Rapunzel is re-told through a very simple script and just a few bite-size songs. This delightful combination of 'Song and Story' will enliven and enrich learning, both in music and literacy, as well as give younger children a manageable experience of performing a mini -musical.

10th December, Christmas Party:

We have put in place a system for contributions, as past experiences have shown that too much food is left over at the end of the event leading to unnecessary and avoidable wastage. While we appreciate your generosity, we have decided to ask parents to contribute SR 100/- which will cover snacks and lunch.
